

## **9 Days Budget Camping Safari, Adventures and Cultures + 8 Days Zanzibar beach holiday**

**Destinations: Arusha National park, Tarangire National park, Lake Manyara National park, Serengeti National park and Ngorongoro crater.**

Budget camping safaris; we use dome tents suit for 2 person equipped with mattresses and pillows, here you have your own professional private chef who will make 3 nice meals a day for you. On the camping safari we provide chairs, tables and all camping gear, we provide also supply car to carry safari gear when we have a big group of 6 people.

Camping safari will bring you close to the nature means you will see animals moving around the camp very close (**but not carnivores**) In the night you can see animals shining eyes, animals snuffing outside your tents what a great experience! If you want to be sure of being very close to nature and wildlife this is the best option Itineraries.

Camping facilities in the park, are clean toilets, showers are available but get hit from the sun. **Zanzibar beach holiday is included on the itinerary but we can separate it and become special for safaris only.**

**Day 01: Arrival Kilimanjaro airport JRO** Meet **Tanzania Tours & Safaris** representative pickup and transfer to Arusha. **Stay overnight Green Mountain lodge.**

### **Day 02: Arusha National park:**

From your overnight lodge, we will pick you up after breakfast, Drive to Arusha National park, enter the Park for game drive, this is the smallest park in the Northern zone, the park is very beautiful with magnificent views of Mount Kilimanjaro and Mount Meru which is within the park. We see many wildlife such as Cape Buffalos, Zebras, Warthog, Many giraffe, Bush buck, Water bucks, Dik diks, red duiker, Baboons, Velvet Monkey, Blue Monkeys and very beautiful Black and White Colobus Monkeys, Elephants, as well as many species of birds. The small Momela and Big Momela lakes are the best place to see aquatic birds including Pink Flamingos, day trip walking and Canoe is possible in this park. **Stay overnight at Green Mountain lodge.**

### **Day 03: Early departure to Tarangire National park:**

Today after breakfast we drive through the Maasai land enjoying the landscape, we arrive at Tarangire National Park gate where we stop for lunch. Enter the park for afternoon game drive. **Stay overnight at Tarangire public camp site.**

### **Day 04: Morning and afternoon game drive at Tarangire Park:**

Tarangire National park is one of the best parks for game viewing in Tanzania. The park was registered first as a Game Reserve in 1957 and became a National park in 1970. The park covers about 2600kmsq. Tarangire park has a natural hydrological regime that ensures year around permanent water. The park is known for its Tarangire river and valley, wetlands, rolling hills, rocky outcrops, acacia woodlands. One of the greatest features and characteristics that sticks in the mind after a visit to Tarangire are the longest living and biggest trees of world, the Baobab trees. During the dry season the park supports the highest density of elephants of all National parks in Tanzania, the other wildlife found here is lion, Cheetah, Leopard, Buffalo, Giraffe, water buck, Grants gazelle, greater and lesser kudu, fringe eared oryx, tree climbing pythons, baboons and monkeys, migratory animals such as zebra and wildebeest. **Stay overnight at Tarangire public camp site.**

### **Day 05: Today we go to Lake Manyara National Park.**

Early morning game drive at Tarangire park. After breakfast we drive across the Great Rift Valley, one of the most dramatic features on earth, extending from the dead sea in Jordan to Mozambique in the South. You will pass through the Maasai land. Lake Manyara National park is renamed after the plant Euphorbia tirucallii, 'Emanyar' in maasai language, and 'ladies fingers' in English. The park was registered in 1960 and covers an area of 330kmsq, of which 220kmsq is covered by lake and the rest by woodland. There is an enormous amount of wildlife such as tree climbing lion, leopard, cheetah, hippopotamus, buffalo, elephant, zebra, wildebeest, baboon, other monkeys, pink flamingo and over 350 bird species. **Stay overnight at Twiga campsite** in Mto Wa Mbu (with small swimming pool).

### **Day 06: Drive to Serengeti National Park; afternoon game-drive:**

After breakfast we head to the Serengeti National park, via Ngorongoro Conservation Area. We will stop at the rim of the crater for a great view of the crater, we make our drive around the crater rim to Serengeti park. Geographical Serengeti is divided into two zones: Eastern-Southern, which is covered with a vast plain made of volcanic ash which was emitted from Ngorongoro highlands, hence the name "Siringet", a Maasai word for endless plain. The second zone, Western-Northern, is woodland and small hills. **Stay overnight at one of the Seronera Campsites** in the centre of the park.

### **Day 07: Full day game drive in Serengeti National Park.**

After breakfast leave your camp for game drive. The Serengeti National park is part of the Serengeti ecosystem which boasts the greatest wildlife concentrations of ungulates: more than 1 million wildebeests and nearly half a million zebras annually follow the rains around this eco system, from the plains to the savannah woodlands, to the masai Mara and back to the plains again. This big migration has been described as the greatest wildlife spectacle on earth.

We will see lion, leopard, cheetah, elephant, Buffalo, gazelle Girafe, Grant and Thomson gazelle. **Stay overnight at Seronera Campsite.**

### **Day 08: Morning game drive in the Serengeti, afternoon drive to Ngorongoro Conservation Area.**

Today we will have a morning game drive at Serengeti park, have a lunch, and in the afternoon drive to Ngorongoro Conservation Area. **Stay overnight at Simba campsite** on the rim of the crater

### **Day 09: Early descend in the crater, morning and afternoon game-drive,**

Descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for game drive.

Ngorongoro is a huge caldera, a collapsed volcano, 265sqkm in size and 610m deep. The Ngorongoro crater is one of the most beautiful wildlife havens in the world. It is a real animal kingdom; here some of Africa's last black rhinos are still well protected. The black mine lions stalk through the grass, flamingos' crowd the Magadi Lake and the giant-tusked elephants are mostly seen along the permanent swamps. Open grass land covers most of the crater floor, turning yellow with wildflowers in the raining season. The Makat soda lake is a great attraction for flamingos and other water birds, while predators hide in the mash to ambush animals that come to drink from the river which feeds the lake. Also on the crater floor are swamps, providing water and habitat for elephant and hippo as well as numerous smaller creatures such as frogs and snakes. Lunch in the crater, late afternoon drive to Arusha. **Stay overnight at Green Mountain Hotel.**

**Day 10:** Transfer to Arusha Airport or Kili airport Fly to Zanzibar.
